SKY LIGHT

An electrical storm off of Catalina and Channel islands was a dazzler

A dazzling lightning storm illuminated the night sky late Sunday and early Monday far off in the distance from Del Cerro Park in Rancho Palos Verdes, above the Terranea Resort. National Weather Service specialist Stuart Seto said 40,000 lightning strikes were seen off coastal Los Angeles, Ventura, Santa Barbara and San Luis Obispo counties from midnight Sunday to 1 a.m. Monday. "Everyone was talking about it," Seto said of the rare conditions that produced an impressive visual display but brought only trace amounts of rain. The system began around the Channel Islands and Catalina Island and moved northward.

State files lawsuit to save DACA

The state of California has filed a lawsuit in federal court to challenge the Trump administration's decision to rescind the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program. The lawsuit, filed in the U.S. District Court in San Diego, seeks to prevent the administration from implementing the policy. California Attorney General Rob Bonta said the lawsuit is necessary to protect the rights of the estimated 1 million DACA recipients in the state.
