Terranea

about Surrounded by water on three sides, Terranea's amenities include a 50,000-square-foot spa, a nine-hole golf course, pools with ocean views, surf lessons, and eight restaurants and bars.

stats & standouts Catalina Point offers unobstructed bluffside vistas for up to 220 guests, while Ocean Lawn can accommodate 25 to 80 or 250 to 400. For larger parties, Palos Verdes Meadows hosts up to 900.

packages Wedding packages begin at \$200 per person for evenings, and increase if weddings last beyond six hours. Daytime weddings start from \$150 per person. Menus are completely customizable.

nearby attractions Catalina Island is just across the channel, while remote Rancho Palos Verdes itself offers hiking, horseback riding and golfing.
